**Reasons For Decision**

The Appellant, [text deleted], is appealing the Internal Review decision dated October 4, 2006, with regards to the termination of her Income Replacement Indemnity benefits for non-compliance with a rehabilitation program made available by MPIC. An appeal hearing was held on July 24, 2008. The Appellant did not attend the hearing or provide any submissions to the Commission in support of her appeal.

Upon a consideration of the totality of the evidence before it, and upon a consideration of the relevant factors surrounding the Appellant's failure to cooperate with the rehabilitation program,

the Commission finds that the Appellant has not provided a valid reason for her failure to cooperate with the rehabilitation program arranged by the case manager.

As a result, the Appellant's appeal is dismissed and the Internal Review decision dated October 4, 2006 is confirmed.
