HEALTH CANADA INFORMATION

Health Canada has issued important Advisories for the following drugs:

On May 30, 2002, Schering Canada Inc., the manufacturer of Garasone and Garamycin, sent a "Dear Healthcare Professional" letter to healthcare workers to warn of the risk of toxicity with the use of topical Garasone and Garamycin ear drops in patients with perforated tympanic membranes.

On June 25, 2002 and July 4, 2002, Janssen-Ortho Inc. and Ortho Biotech-Consumer Information, the manufacturers of Eprex (epoetin alfa), sent a "Dear Healthcare Professional" letter to healthcare workers and an advisory to consumers to inform about Pure Red Cell Aplasia.

On July 18, 2002, Sigma-Tau Pharmaceuticals, Inc., the manufacturer of Matulane (procarbazine hydrochloride) capsules (formerly marketed under the name Natulan), sent a "Dear Healthcare Professional" letter to healthcare workers to inform about the development of lung cancer as a secondary nonlymphoid malignancy in Hodgkin's patients receiving the MOPP regimen (mechlorethamine, vincristine, procarbazine and prednisone) as therapy.

In July 2002, Novartis Pharmaceuticals Inc., the manufacturer of Lioresal intrathecal (baclofen), sent a "Dear Healthcare Professional" letter to healthcare workers to warn about rare cases of intrathecal baclofen withdrawal that can lead to life threatening sequelae and/or death in patients who abruptly discontinue therapy.
