

Critical Incidents Reported to Manitoba Health

Period: July 1, 2021 - September 30, 2021

Note: Critical incidents related to COVID-19 outbreaks in hospitals or personal care homes are reported as groups.

| Fiscal Year Occurred | Degree of Injury | Description |
|----------------------|------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized. |
| 2021/22 | Death | Patient developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Incorrect device placed during surgical procedure. Client discharged home. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Resident was being transferred using the Hoyer lift and fell out of the sling, sustaining fractured ribs. |
| 2021/22 | Death | A necessary communication device was not available to a resident to make their needs known. |
| 2021/22 | Major | An unintended medication was provided to a patient that resulted in the need for emergency intervention. |
| 2021/22 | Death | Resident developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A resident developed a Stage 3 pressure injury while in care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient presented to the ER for specialist consultation. A delay in assessment and treatment occurred resulting in the need for critical intervention. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced delays in accessing emergency care for an acute medical event. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client fell while being transferred by staff using a mechanical lift sustaining serious injury. Client remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced a cardiac arrest requiring transfer to a higher level of care. Opportunities to provide closer monitoring were not fully realized. |
| 2021/22 | Death | A patient was discharged to transitional housing. Opportunities to assess and provide necessary supports were not fully realized. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced acute deterioration as a result of a medical device failure. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced a fall resulting in a fracture requiring surgical intervention. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Delay in timely diagnostic evaluation contributed to clinical deterioration requiring additional interventions. Client was transported to a tertiary care center and remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient with an acute mental health condition experienced serious harm during a gap in monitoring. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Patient fell in hallway resulting in fracture. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Patient developed a Stage 3 Pressure Injury related to recent decline in physical mobility (utilizing a wheelchair). |
| 2021/22 | Major | A client developed a pressure related skin injury; opportunities to mitigate the injury were not consistently realized. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client deteriorated and required care at tertiary care facility. Client remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Death | While waiting for medical assessment, a patient experienced a sudden change in their health status requiring critical intervention. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A patient developed a pressure related injury. The opportunity to mitigate the risk was not consistently realized. |
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| 2021/22 | Major | Medication error resulted in client requiring escalation of care and extension of hospital stay. Client remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Death | An opportunity for earlier intervention was not recognized. The patient deteriorated and required a higher level of care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client sustained a laceration while being transferred which resulted in admission to hospital. The client remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | An unstageable pressure injury developed during hospitalization. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client's condition deteriorated following a procedure resulting in admission to hospital. Client remained in care. |
| 2021/22 | Death | Unsafe mode of transportation utilized for an interfacility transfer of an unstable patient. Upon arrival to the receiving facility the patient was then airlifted to a higher level of care and died. |

| 2021/22 | Major | Resident had an unwitnessed fall from bed resulting in a transfer to the Emergency Dept and treatment of a fracture. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client sustained a serious burn from baseboard heater. Client transferred to hospital, remained in care with ongoing wound care. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Patient suffered delay in treatment and diagnosis of osteomyelitis. |
| 2021/22 | Major | A delay in a patient transfer between sites resulted in a missed opportunity for early intervention |
| 2021/22 | Death | Patient appears to have experienced a delay in treatment. Not all strategies to recognize and prevent deterioration seem to have been established in a timely manner. |
| 2021/22 | Death | A patient presented with an acute medical illness. Early opportunities to diagnose and treat the patient's complex condition were not realized. |
| 2021/22 | Death | A patient's condition deteriorated. Opportunities for additional assessment and treatment were not initially identified. |
| 2021/22 | Death | Resident developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome. |
| 2021/22 | Death | A patient experienced a delay in diagnosis and treatment of an acute medical condition. |
| 2021/22 | Major | Client fell and experienced fracture. Client discharged home. |
| 2021/22 | Death | Client experienced clinical deterioration while in care. |
