2021/22	Major	A specimen was left out overnight and when found, it was not in a condition which could be processed for diagnostics. Another biopsy is required. Delay in diagnosis as well as potential delay in treatment.
2021/22	Major	Patients developed a healthcare acquired infection.
2021/22	Major	A resident experienced a preventable fall resulting in fracture.
2021/22	Major	The patient underwent a procedure resulting in serious harm and requiring hospitalization. The opportunity to consult the specialist was missed.
2021/22	Major	The patient experienced an unusual extension of a hospital stay as a result of complications associated with removal of a medical device.
2021/22	Death	A patient was transferred to a medical facility due to their poor medical status.

Fiscal Year Occurred	Degree of Injury	Description
2021/22	Major	Opportunities for reassessment and treatment, and acquisition of appropriate transport resources prior to patient transfer were not realized. This resulted in a deterioration in the patient's medical condition during transport that required life-saving treatment.
2021/22	Major	Stage 3 pressure injury developed while in care.
2021/22	Unknown	Residents developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome.
2021/22	Major	A patient experienced an acute change in their condition that was recognized by care providers, however a delay in investigation and treatment occurred resulting in functional impairment.
2021/22	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2021/22	Major	Patients developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome.
2021/22	Major	Patients developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome.
2021/22	Death	Delay in treatment resulting in patient death.
2021/22	Major	A patient experienced a delay in intervention for an acute medical condition.
