

Critical Incidents Reported to Manitoba Health

Fiscal Year Occurred	Degree of Injury	Description
2019/20	Major	A resident had a fall resulting in significant injury. Opportunities to reassess the resident's fall risk prior to the event did not occur.
2019/20	Major	A patient was discharged prior to investigation and treatment of a medical condition resulting in patient deterioration and readmission to hospital.
2019/20	Major	A resident fell resulting in a broken bone. Not all fall prevention interventions were in place at the time of the resident's fall.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced an acute change in their condition that was recognized by care providers, however, a delay in activating standard protocols for investigation and treatment occurred resulting in permanent loss of function.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced injury-related skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Major	Client fell in dining room and sustained severe head injury. Care and comfort measures in place.
2019/20	Death	A resident experienced an episode of choking. While immediate interventions were provided, there was a delay in activating emergency services.
2019/20	Death	A patient presented with a medical problem. The opportunity for admission and further assessment did not occur.
2019/20	Major	A delay in recognition of an acute condition resulted in deterioration and cardiac arrest requiring resuscitation.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Major	An independently mobile patient fell resulting in a broken bone. The opportunity to mitigate risks in the patient's environment was not fully realized.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not realized.
2019/20	Major	Client found on the bathroom floor following an unwitnessed fall, which resulted in a wrist fracture. Surgical repair required.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown related to a medical device requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Major	Resident developed stage 3 pressure injury to coccyx while in care. Resident remains in PCH with ongoing wound assessment and treatment.
2019/20	Major	Client fell from wheelchair while being loaded into handi-transit van, resulting in fractured right hip.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Death	A patient presented with an acute medical concern. While an initial assessment and care plan was completed, the opportunity to consult with additional clinical experts regarding the treatment plan did not occur.
2019/20	Death	A patient presented with an acute medical concern. While initial interventions were completed, implementation of additional interventions to address increased risks associated with the diagnosis did not occur.
2019/20	Major	Delay in diagnosis and transfer of a cardiac patient to a higher level of care.
2019/20	Major	Management of a chest tube resulted in complications for the patient.
2019/20	Major	Medication error and delayed lab testing resulted in kidney failure and patient requiring hemodialysis treatment.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.

Fiscal Year Occurred	Degree of Injury	Description
2019/20	Death	A pregnant client was admitted to the facility in the afternoon due to labour. During the night, a crash C-Section was completed for a stillborn infant. A critical incident review is being undertaken to gain a better understanding of this event.
2019/20	Death	A patient presented to hospital with a severe and acute medical condition. While care was ongoing, opportunities for additional interventions were not realized.
2019/20	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown to the heel requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2019/20	Major	Resident developed preventable stage 4 pressure injury related to medical appliance.
2019/20	Major	A patient developed a pressure related skin injury and gaps in interventions to mitigate the risk existed.
2019/20	Major	A patient fell resulting in pain to hip. Assessment determined a fracture requiring surgical intervention.
2019/20	Major	A patient sustained a fall resulting in a hip fracture.
