

Community Notification Process

1. Federal or Provincial Corrections, Police and/or Community identify high-risk sexual offender.
2. Notify Police.
3. Police bring case to Committee. Offender notified before Committee deliberates.
4. Committee considers written submission from offender. Committee examines information and assess risk.
5. Committee Recommendation is either for a full public notification, a limited public notification, targeted notification, no notification, or other measures.
6. Police consider the Committee recommendation.
7. Police release/do not release information.
