1 THE CHAIRPERSON: The panel members have
2 conferred on this matter and have rendered a decision
3 which is as follows:

4 We conclude that based on the evidence
5 before us today it has not been proved beyond a
6 reasonable doubt that there was an abuse of authority on
7 behalf of Sergeant M. in this matter. In other
8 words, that allegation is dismissed by this Board.

9 The Board, however, does have a few
10 comments, first being the Board feels that it was unwise
11 for Sergeant M. to attend at Mr. C. 's home or
12 to involve himself in a matter or in any investigation,
13 assessment, or contact where the complainant or
14 informant is a family member or not at arms length. In
15 fact we feel it would be unwise for any officer to
16 involve himself thus, and we feel that if there is no
17 such policy in place within the Winnipeg Police
18 Department there should be.

19 Our other comment is we trust that our
20 decision here today will lay this matter to rest and
21 that the Board feels it appropriate that there need be
22 no further contact between the two parties.

23 MR. C. : If I have any writing to do I
24 will do it to his office.
