23.1 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding ONE MILLION, THREE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS for ENERGY AND MINES:

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2000.

23.2 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding NINE MILLION, FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS for ENERGY AND MINES:

ENERGY AND MINERAL RESOURCES \$9,493,400.00

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2000.

23.3 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding THREE MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS for ENERGY AND MINES:

INDUSTRY SUPPORT PROGRAMS \$3,563,100.00

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2000.

23.4 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS for ENERGY AND MINES:

AMORTIZATION OF CAPITAL ASSETS \$224,100.00
