**PRAYER**

Immediately following the Prayer, Mr. KINEW rose on a Matter of Privilege alleging the Government was abusing the Rules by bringing in a large volume of legislation and therefore limiting the opportunities for debate and moved:

THAT the issue of the Pallister Government's abuse of the rules of this House and its undemocratic practices be immediately referred to a Committee of this House.

And Hon. Messrs. GOERTZEN and GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, Ms. FONTAINE rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the fact that the Auditor General has given a qualified opinion on the last two provincial budgets and that the Government has been misrepresenting their financial statements and moved:

THAT this matter be moved to an all party committee officiated by the Auditor General of Manitoba for discussion

And Hon. Messrs. GOERTZEN and GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, Mr. WIEBE rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the Government's failure to bring forward their first quarter financial report and moved:

THAT this matter be moved to an all party committee for consideration

And Hon. Messrs. GOERTZEN and GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, Mr. LINDSEY rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the lack of a Crown Corporation meeting recently to consider reports from MPI and moved:

THAT this issue be immediately referred to a Committee of this House.

And Hon. Messrs. GOERTZEN and GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, MLA ASAGWARA rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the Premier and his Minister's wilfulness to put false information on the record related to the funding and effectiveness of nutrition programs and moved:

THAT the Matter be moved to an all party committee for consideration.

And Hon. Messrs. GOERTZEN and GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, Ms. FONTAINE rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the Government's summary budgeting act, suggesting that it amounted to a contempt of the House and moved:

THAT this matter be moved to an all party committee for consideration.

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.

Subsequently following the Prayer, Mr. WASYLIW rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding cuts to the public service made by the Government and the removal of public accountability and moved:

THAT this matter be moved to an all party committee for consideration.

And Hon. Mr. GERRARD having spoken,

WHEREUPON Madam Speaker informed the House she would take the matter under advisement.
