PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

Ms. KORZENIOWSKI – Reserve Forces Week

18. WHEREAS the Province of Manitoba recognizes the many citizens of this province who are, and have been, members of the Canadian Reserve Forces, and who make a significant continuing contribution to the cultural, social, and economic fabric of the province; and

WHEREAS the dedicated women and men of the Navy, Army, Air and Communications Reserves are integral members of the civilian community and also serve in Canada's Armed Forces on a part-time basis, thereby fulfilling a vital role in the maintenance of Canada's defense commitments; and

WHEREAS the Province of Manitoba appreciates the service that reservists provide to those outside Canada through peacekeeping, and other military and humanitarian missions; and

WHEREAS the skills, values and knowledge reservists acquire through their military training make them valued employees and exemplary citizens.
