RESOLUTION:

Mr. EICHLER – Apology for Per-Vote Subsidy

19. WHEREAS the current Provincial Government enacted the Elections Finances Amendment Act in 2008; and

WHEREAS the content of the amendment is an undemocratic concept that unnecessarily burdens taxpayers; and

WHEREAS the amendment forces Manitobans to financially support a political party against their wishes; and

WHEREAS the Federal Government should be commended for proposing to eliminate the federal per-vote subsidy; and

WHEREAS the New Democratic Party has followed the example set by the Progressive Conservative Party of Manitoba by also rejecting the annual allowance of the per-vote subsidy every year since 2008.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba ask the Provincial Government to apologize for enacting per-vote subsidy legislation and for refusing to repeal it in case it accepts the annual allowance in the future.
