Ms. Shirley Strutt (Legislative Counsel): Mr. Chairperson, as required by Rule 108 of the Rules of the House, I now report that I have examined Bill No. 89, An Act to Amend an Act to Incorporate United Health Services Corporation, and have not noted any

exceptional powers sought or any other provision of the Bill requiring special consideration.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. Does the sponsoring MLA have an opening statement?

Mr. Helmut Pankratz (La Verendrye): Mr. Chairman, if I may, I would like to at this time just state that consultation has been taking place with both Opposition Parties, and they felt it was a good change to the Bill. They also approved speedy passage of it. So with that, those are the only comments I would like to make at this time.

Mr. Chairman: Does the critic for the official Opposition have a statement? Mr. Mandrake.

Mr. Ed Mandrake (Assiniboia): We do not have any opposition to having this Bill passed and receiving Royal Assent.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. Does the critic for the Second Opposition Party have an opening statement? Mr. Harapiak.

Mr. Harry Harapiak (The Pas): We have no . . . Bill. We have consulted on this, and we agree to pass it on to the next stage.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. The Bill will be considered clause by clause during the consideration of the Bill. The Title and the Preamble are postponed until all other clauses have been considered in their proper order by the committee.- (interjection)- We will do it clause by clause.

Let us start with Clause 1—pass; Clauses 7(1) to 7(5)—pass; Clause 2—pass; Preamble—pass; Title—pass. Shall the Bill be reported? Agreed. Is it the will of the committee that I report the Bill? Agreed.
