## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION



## UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT OF GRAND RAPIDS, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Local Government District of Grand Rapids filed a registration with the department in connection with the operation of a sewage treatment plant located in part of Section 34, Township 48, Range 13 WPM in the said Local Government District with discharge of effluent to Lake Winnipeg;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions set by a regulation, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to set limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice of its intention to set limits, terms and conditions, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the operation on the 15th day of January, 1988;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall not discharge effluent from the said sewage treatment plant
  - (a) where the organic content of the said effluent as indicated by the five day biochemical oxygen demand, is in excess of 30 milligrams per litre;
  - (b) where the faecal coliform content of the said effluent as indicated by the MPN index, is in excess of 200 per 100 millilitres of sample;
  - (c) where the total coliform content of the said effluent as indicated by the MPN index, is in excess of 1500 per 100 millilitres of sample.

- The Applicant shall operate and maintain the said sewage treatment plant in such a manner that the release of offensive odours is minimized.
- 3. The Applicant shall dispose of waste sludge produced by the sewage treatment plant in a manner satisfactory to the Environmental Management Division.
- 4. The Applicant shall measure the residual chlorine content of the effluent from the said sewage treatment plant and shall record and submit the said data to the said Division in such a manner as is satisfactory to the Division.
