THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

MANITOBA HYDRO; APPLICANT

The following terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction and operation of the La Verendrye-Mohawk to Assiniboine Loudoun 115 kV Transmission Line and the Assiniboine Loudoun Station located in South Charleswood, City of Winnipeg:

1. The Applicant shall construct the transmission line on the location described as Route A in The Environment Act Proposal dated September 5, 1991.
2. The Applicant shall construct the station on the location described as Site 3 in The Environment Act Proposal, dated September 5, 1991.
3. The Applicant shall not cause or permit the emission of sound from the station, which when measured beyond the property line of the station in a residential area to exceed an hourly equivalent sound level of 45 dB(A) during the nighttime hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. local time.
4. The Applicant shall install oil spill containment equipment around the station transformers consistent with Plans and Specifications to be approved by the Director prior to placement of the oil containment equipment at the site.
