for the expansion and operation of the Development being the Oakwood Golf Course located on Pt. NW 1/4 13-8-7 EPM in the Rural Municipality of Ste. Anne and subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

1) The Licencee shall construct the expansion in accordance with the Routing Plan filed with the Environment Act Proposal, dated November 24, 1992.

LIMITS. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 2) The Licencee shall obtain an annual Pesticide Use Permit pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 94/88R for the storage, handling and application of pesticides in conjunction with the Development.
- 3) The Licencee shall not use any mercury based fungicides at the Development.
- 4) The Licencee shall locate a pesticide storage facility in a separate, dry, well ventilated building that will not flood, and construct the facility in such a manner that it will contain runoff from the complete pesticide storage area. The pesticide storage facility shall be enclosed with a security fence.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the specifications, limits terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily, or permanently, this Licence.
