for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #459 from Provincial Trunk Highway #1 to Provincial Trunk Highway #10 in the Rural Municipalities of Whitehead and Cornwallis and the City of Brandon subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS .TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Highways and Transportation Location Plan of P.R. #459 (Valley Road), Sheets 1 to 6, filed as part of the Environment Act Proposal, dated November 19, 1992.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, reach an agreement with the Department of Environment Park-West Region on the location of an asphalt batching plant associated with the Development.
- 3. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are contained by an impermeable dyke in accordance with *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
- 4. The Licencee shall, during and upon completion of construction of the Development, collect and dispose of all waste petroleum products in accordance with all applicable legislated requirements.
- 5. The Licencee shall, upon completion of construction, cleanup and remove all debris from the construction site and dispose of the debris at a Registered Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to MR 150/91 respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.
