THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #256 from Provincial Road #467 to Provincial Trunk Highway #41 near the Village of McAuley in the Rural Municipality of Archie subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS .TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Highways and Transportation Location Plan No. 6019, P.R. #256 New Location (W. Jct. P.R. # 467 to Jct. P.T.H. #41) Sheets 1 to 3, filed as part of the Environment Act Proposal, dated November 26, 1992.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, reach an agreement with the Department of Environment Park-West Region on the location of asphalt batching plant associated with the Development.
- 3. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that all fuel storage areas comply with the requirements of the "Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation", Manitoba Regulation 97/88R.
- 4. The Licencee shall, during and upon completion of construction of the Development, collect and dispose of all waste petroleum products in accordance with the requirements of the *Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act*, R.S.M. 1987 c. D12, and its Regulations.
- 5. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91R respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.
