THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF NATURAL RESOURCES: The "Licencee"

for the Development being the use of a controlled burn to improve moose habitat and increase the carrying capacity of approximately 1,000 hectares of the Saskeram Wildlife Management Area (WMA). The area to be burned includes sections 11 and 14, and parts of sections 1, 2, 12, 13, 15, 23, and 26 in Township 58, Range 28 WPM.

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall conduct the controlled burn in accordance with the Manitoba Natural Resources Environment Act Proposal, Controlled Burn, and the addendum, Monitoring, filed with Manitoba Environment on January 21, and March 12, 1993, respectively.
- 2. The Licencee shall not conduct any burn activities associated with the Development between May 25th and December 31st of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall, at least one week prior to the controlled burn, provide notice of the activity through newspaper advertisements and community notices on local television and radio stations.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms, and/or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
