In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

The Town of Morris: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a sewage forcemain replacement under the Morris River in River Lots 337 and 339 in the Parish of Ste. Agathe connecting Mary Street South and Mary Street North in the Town of Morris, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated March 18, 1993, and submitted by Poetker MacLaren Limited on behalf of the Licencee.
- 2) The Licencee shall reseed soil exposed as a result of construction of the Development with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 3) The Licencee shall replace any trees and shrubs associated with flood control works which are removed during the construction of the Development.
- 4) The Licencee shall restore the river banks affected by the Development to their pre-construction gradient and condition, and shall ensure that all construction debris is removed.
- 5) The Licencee shall not undertake construction activities which disturb the banks or the channel of the Morris River between ice breakup and June 15 of any year.
- 6) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 7) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
