THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF
HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION:
The "Licencee"**

for the construction of the Development being a bridge crossing of the Birch River on Provincial Road #608 located east of Section 2, Township 4, Range 13 East in the Local Government District of Reynolds subject to the following specifications, terms and conditions:

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Preferred Alternative "A" as shown in Manitoba Department of Highways and Transportation Environment Act Proposal, *McMunn Access Structure Replacement*, dated March, 1993.
2. The Licencee shall, during construction, adhere to the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources guidelines titled *Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba*.
3. The Licencee shall, during the fish spawning period from ice breakup to June 15th of each year during construction, cease construction activities that will impact upon the stream channel.
4. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from the high water line of the Birch River at bank full conditions, and shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
5. The Licencee shall ensure that, at the completion of bridge construction, disturbed areas of the river bank are stabilized from channel level to high water elevation at bank-full conditions.
6. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to the *Manitoba Waste Disposal Ground Regulation, Manitoba Regulation, 150/91*.
