THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

## THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #255 beginning at the junction with Provincial Trunk Highway #83 in the Rural Municipality of Pipestone and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 17.7 km. to the junction with Provincial Road #254 in the Rural Municipality of Sifton subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

## SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Department of Highways & Transportation Environment Act Proposal, *Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Road #255 (from PTH #83 to PR #254*), filed with the Department on February 2, 1993.
- 2) The Licencee shall, prior to construction startup, instruct the on-site project construction supervisor to contact the Manitoba Environment Brandon Office to ensure compliance with the terms of this Licence and other applicable regulatory requirements.
- The Licencee shall, prior to construction, reach an agreement with Manitoba Environment Park-West Region on the location of the asphalt batching plant associated with the Development.
- 4) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, consult and reach an agreement with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources and Manitoba Hydro regarding the method of placement of all hydro poles to be relocated into wetland areas.
- 5) The Licencee shall, following completion of construction, remove all access roads to borrow sites associated with the Development.
- 6) The Licencee shall ensure that all fuel storage areas associated with the Development comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation.

- 7) The Licencee shall dispose of all sewage and sullage from sanitary facilities associated with the Development in accordance with *Manitoba Regulation* 95/88R respecting *Private Sewage Disposal Systems and Privies*.
- 8) The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91R respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.
- 9) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any construction camps related to the Development comply with all requirements of *Manitoba Regulation* 35/88R respecting *Industrial and Construction Camp Regulation*.
- 10) This Licence replaces Licence #1660 which is hereby rescinded.

## REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
