THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Manitoba Natural Resources. Ducks Unlimited Canada, the Environmental Partners Fund and the Manitoba Habitat Heritage Corporation: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a wetland habitat enhancement project in sections 20, 21, 22, 23, 27 and 28-3-6E in the Local Government District of Stuartburn subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated September 1, 1993 and the accompanying Environmental Impact Assessment dated August, 1993.
- 2. The Licencee shall, before commencing construction, receive the Director's approval for the design of fish screens for the water intake and the outlet control structure and a maintenance plan for these structures.
- 3. The Licencee shall, before commencing operation of the Development, receive the Director's approval for a monitoring plan and a contingency plan which address pike entrapment in the impoundment.
- 4. The Licencee shall, within six months of commencing construction, submit for the approval of the Director a detailed fish habitat enhancement plan. The plan shall include a schedule for construction.
- 5. The Licencee shall reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 6. The Licencee shall install appropriate riprap or alternative means of minimizing water erosion in areas of high water velocity.
- 7. The Licencee shall connect external borrow areas to provide continuous pathways to allow fish escape to the Rat River.

- 8. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 9. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
