for the construction and operation of the Development being a fish spawning enhancement weir near the outlet of Line Lake in SE 33-32-25W in Duck Mountain Provincial Park subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated May 6, 1993 and additional information provided to Manitoba Environment dated January 13, 1994.
- 2. The Licencee shall not undertake construction activities between April 1 and June 30 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall protect erodible streambanks disturbed by construction with riprap and reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 4. The Licencee shall remove access created to construct the Development in accordance with the directions of the District Natural Resources Officer.
- 5. The Licencee shall block access to the Development at Provincial Road 366 in accordance with the directions of the District Natural Resources Officer.
- 6. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 7. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
