THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

## THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of a section of Provincial Trunk Highway #44 beginning at the west junction of PTH #12 to 0.8 km west of the east junction of PTH #12 in the Rural Municipality of Brokenhead subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

## SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal Four Laning of PTH #44 (from the west junction of PTH #12 to 0.8 km east of the east junction of PTH #12), dated September 12, 1993.
- 2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, obtain a timber permit from the Department of Natural Resources for cutting and removal of any timber from Crown land associated with the Development.
- 3. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, reach an agreement with the Department of Natural Resources, Eastern Regional Office or the Department of Natural Resources Forestry Branch regarding the replacement of productive forest land related to the Development.
- 4. The Licence shall, prior to disposing any vegetation debris left from the clearing of the highway right-of-way, reach an agreement with the Regional Environment Officer on the method of disposal.

- 5. The Licencee shall collect and dispose of all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and other legislated requirements.
- 6. The Licencee shall, during construction, comply with all requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
- 7. The Licencee shall, upon completion of construction, cleanup and deposit all non-hazardous waste and debris from the construction activities at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to MR 150/91 respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.

## **REVOCATION**

If in the opinion of the Minister the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not or is not complying with the specifications, terms and conditions set out herein, the Minister may revoke temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
