In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Trunk Highway #16 beginning at the junction with PTH #21 in the Rural Municipality of Shoal Lake and extending in a south easterly direction along the existing PTH #16 right-of-way to west of the junction with PR #354 in the Rural Municipality of Strathclair subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Trunk Highway #16 (from the PTH #21 to west of PR #354), dated May 7, 1994.
- 2) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, consult and reach an agreement with the Department of Natural Resources Regional Wildlife staff, regarding a site specific plan to maximize waterfowl production on the wetland areas affected by the Development.
- 3) The Licencee shall, prior to relocation of any wood hydro poles within wetland areas related to the Development, consult and reach an agreement with Manitoba Hydro and the Department of Natural Resources Regional wildlife staff regarding the method of pole placement.
- 4) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that all fuel storage areas associated with the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from wetlands, and ensure that the storage areas comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation.
- 5) The Licencee shall, during and upon completion of construction of the Development, collect and dispose of all waste petroleum products generated by the construction activities in accordance with all applicable regulatory requirements.
- The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91R respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.
