THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

## THE MANITOBA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES: "the Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being erosion protection works on the Red River immediately downstream of the Red River Floodway Inlet Control Structure adjacent to River Lots 73, 74, 176 and 177 in the Parish of St. Norbert subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

## SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with The Environment Act Proposal dated June 26, 1995.
- 2. The Licencee shall not construct the Development before September 1 or after November 30 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall obtain the advice of Central Region staff of Manitoba Manitoba Natural Resources respecting final design and construction details before proceeding with the construction of the Development.
- 4. The Licencee shall advise the Director of the Winnipeg Region of Manitoba Environment and the Director of the Central Region of Manitoba Natural Resources not less than two weeks prior to the construction of the Development.
- 5. The Licencee shall ensure that material used in the construction of the Development is void of silts and other fine material which could increase suspended sediment loads in the Red River.
- 6. The Licencee shall revegetate soil exposed by the construction of the Development with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 7. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.

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8. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 metres away from any waterbody, and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

## REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
