for the construction only of the Development being an expansion to be existing potato processing plant, located on Lot 1 on Ninth Avenue in the industry of Particle City of Portage la Prairie and the installation of equipment therein in accordance with the Proposal filed under The Environment Act on March 21, 1996, and reletter of a eration dated May, 10, 1996, and subject to the following specifications; units, and and onditions:

- 1. The Licencee shall implement good ousek uping and operational practices with respect to the Development, at all times.
- 2. The Licencee shall under ake all construction activities such that a minimum disturbance is created in advent residental areas.
- 3. The Licencee shall teache the sodue on and dissemination of wastes by initiating and maintaining a aste reduction and waste recycling programs.

#### SPF JEFICATIONS LIMITES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 4. The A sence is hereby authorized to undertake the following activities at the Development:
  - i) constant an addition to the existing potato processing structure;
  - ii) install an additional potato processing line within this structure; install pollution control equipment including the relocation and reorientation of roof-top equipment;
  - iv construct a new boiler room;
  - install a starch recovery system in the waste water treatment line;
  - vi) install and connect water, sanitary sewer, electrical and other services as needed to the structures and equipment therein;
  - vii) decommission and construct petroleum product storage tanks in accordance with applicable Regulations;

- viii) construct 2 aboveground cooking oil storage tanks, with secondary containment:
- ix) remove from service the existing waste water primary clarifier when authorized by written approval of the Director;
- (x) construct a noise-attenuating berm at the north side of the Development;
- (xi) construct roadways and vehicle use areas within the Developmen
- xii) construct a new waste water primary clarifier and sludge handle system; and
- xiii) construct an odour control system for the clarifier and sly ge handling system.
- 5. The Licencee shall, as deemed necessary by the Director for he on using a ressment of the alteration, provide information to the Director in witing, resuch form (including number of copies), and of such contact, as may be required by the Director.
- The Licencee shall submit, for the Director's appror than September 1, 6. and ved in adv. 1996, or at such later date as may be appr e by he Director, a financial assurance plan, outlining the financial as sms and the dollar amount the Licencee proposes respecting the indirial wastewater pretreatment system. Subsequent to the approval of the finan ance plan, the Licencee may submit, al ass to the Director for approval, pr s to the plan. The Licencee shall idme. red ar implement any amendments proved by the irector in a manner and within the time frames specified by the Dire
- 7. The Licencee shall comply with all requirements of The Dangerous Goods Handling And Transportation Act and The Environment Act and their associated Regulations including the Storige and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation.
- 8. The Licence shall carry of any remedial measures or modifications to the construct a works authorized under this Licence which may be deemed necessary by the Director to assure effective environmental management or for any other reason pertains to be safety of the construction in this Licence and in any subsequent stage in the licence ang of the Development. Such remedial measures or modifications shall be uncertaken within a time frame to be specified by the Director, and in a manner to be approved by the Director.

#### **REVIEW AND REVOCATION**

A. If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding or has or is failing to meet the specifications, limits, terms, or conditions set out in this Licence, the Director may, temporarily or permanently, revoke this Licence.
