## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

## UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and CELL-U-FILL LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Cell-U-Fill Ltd. filed an application with the department of Mines, Natural Resources and Environment in connection with the operation of a cellulose insulation manufacturing plant located at or near 1373 Spruce Street in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the said application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation:

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 17th day of April, 1979;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall ensure that process modifications are made and/or equipment is installed such that:
  - on and after the 1st day of July, 1979 particulate emissions from the various processes of the said operation do not exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission:
- (b) on and after the 1st day of July, 1979 particulate matter from any source of the said operation does not become airborne to such an extent that particulate matter remains visible past the property line of APRIL 25 the said operation.

2. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the requirements of Clause 1 of this Order.
