AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and MR. JAMES CRANG, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Mr. James Crang filed a proposal with the Department in connection with the operation of a septic tank and disposal field to serve the Shilo Inn located on Lot 47, Plan 1298 of the Spruce Woods Subdivision in the Rural Municipality of Cornwallis;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under The Clean Environment Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice, the Commission received a representation from a person who is or who is likely to be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS


the Commission held a hearing on the 28th day of July, 1980, at Shilo, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the proposal on the 18th day of August, 1980;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Applicant shall not permit the septic tank to be located closer than:
 - (a) 3.0 meters from the property boundary; or
 - (b) 8.0 meters from any well.
- 2. The Applicant shall not permit the septic field to be located closer than:
 - (a) 8.0 meters from the property boundary; or
 - (b) 30.0 meters from any well.



- 3. The Applicant shall construct, maintain and operate the said septic tank and disposal field in such a manner as to:
 - (a) prevent the disruption of adjacent soil;
 - (b) minimize the release of offensive odours; and
 - (c) prevent the contamination of groundwater.
