

Hi Jason,

I think both routes would be considered Type E drains until they meet the La Salle River (Type A).

The east route drain has lots of gradient control structures and looks like where it meets the Floodway Road/Brunkild Dyke that there is potentially a pumping station or a screened stand pipe/control gate to let high flows through. Outside of a major flood event backing water up to floodway Road, the drainage area for this drain looks too small to attract fish.

Good morning Todd,

I'm working on an EAP for the Community of La Salle lagoon expansion with two discharge routes (see attached Google Earth snapshots).

The first attachment is for the existing route and the second attachment is for the proposed route. I've consulted the Milani Report which does not show either drain and I'm hoping that you may be able to give me some direction as to the type of habitat these drains would provide.

The drain in the proposed discharge route is relatively new, which is why it probably isn't showing up on the report maps. It is approximately 3.5 metres deep (near the lagoon area).

Attachment three (100_9109.jpg) is a photo of the existing drain looking north from PR 247. Attachment four (100_9098.jpg) is a photo of the proposed drain looking south from PR 247. You can also take a look at Google Earth Street View to see more of both of these drains.

Any information you can provide to assist with these drains would be great.



Thank you for your information request. I completed a search of the Manitoba Conservation Data Centre's rare species database and found no occurrences at this time for your area of interest.

The information provided in this letter is based on existing data known to the Manitoba Conservation Data Centre at the time of the request. These data are dependent on the research and observations of CDC staff and others who have shared their data, and reflect our current state of knowledge. **An absence of data in any particular geographic area does not necessarily mean that species or ecological communities of concern are not present**; in many areas, comprehensive surveys have never been completed. Therefore, this information should be regarded neither as a final statement on the occurrence of any species of concern, nor as a substitute for on-site surveys for species as part of environmental assessments.

Because the Manitoba CDC's Biotics database is continually updated and because information requests are evaluated by type of action, any given response is only appropriate for its respective request. Please contact the Manitoba CDC for an update on this natural heritage information if more than six months pass before it is utilized.
