Re: Maple Leaf Foods Inc. – Environment Act Licence No. 240V – Notice of Alteration

Receipt of your November 25, 2019 submission is acknowledged as a Notice of Alteration in accordance with Section 14 of The Environment Act.

The requested changes to the Development as Licensed are the expansion of the existing powerhouse and the replacement of two existing boilers.

Specifically, the request is to expand the powerhouse footprint by approximately 5400 sq. ft. and replace the two old existing boilers with new efficient boilers. Four direct contact water heaters (10,000 BTU/hr. each) will also be installed to produce the plant's hot water requirements.

The potential environmental effect of the requested change to the Development as Licensed is insignificant and considered to be a minor alteration in accordance with Section 14(2) of The Environment Act. Approval is hereby granted for the powerhouse expansion, boiler replacements and water heater installations as described in the November 25th, 2019 submission.
