Re: Maple Leaf Food Inc. – Environment Act Licence No. 2311 S2 R4 – Notice of Alteration

Receipt of your April 25, 2014 letter is acknowledged as a notice of alteration in accordance with Section 14 of *The Environment Act*.

The requested change to the Development as Licensed is the continued use of the temporary manure storage facility, which was approved on February 21, 2014, for a period of three months beyond the original April 30th, 2014 deadline.

The potential environmental effect of the requested change to the Development as Licensed is insignificant and considered to be a minor alteration in accordance with section 14(2) of *The Environment Act*. Approval is hereby granted for the continued use of the temporary manure storage pad as described in your April 25, 2014 letter. The approval for the storage of manure at this temporary location terminates on July 31, 2014. Maple Leaf Foods Inc. is required to submit a long term manure management plan for the site to the Environmental Approvals Branch on or before June 30, 2014. Further deadline extensions for the use of the temporary manure storage facility will not be granted.
