Map illustrates the estimated extent of the dewatered area when the spillway is not in operation. The true extent of this area is uncertain due to the limited bathymetric data.

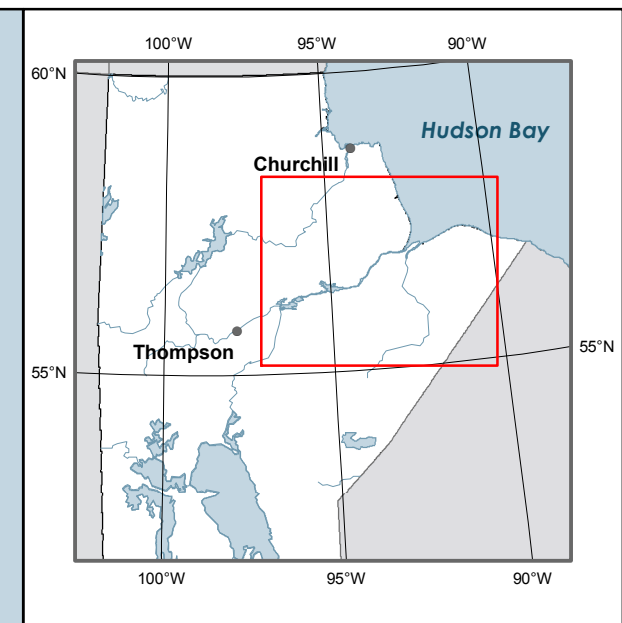
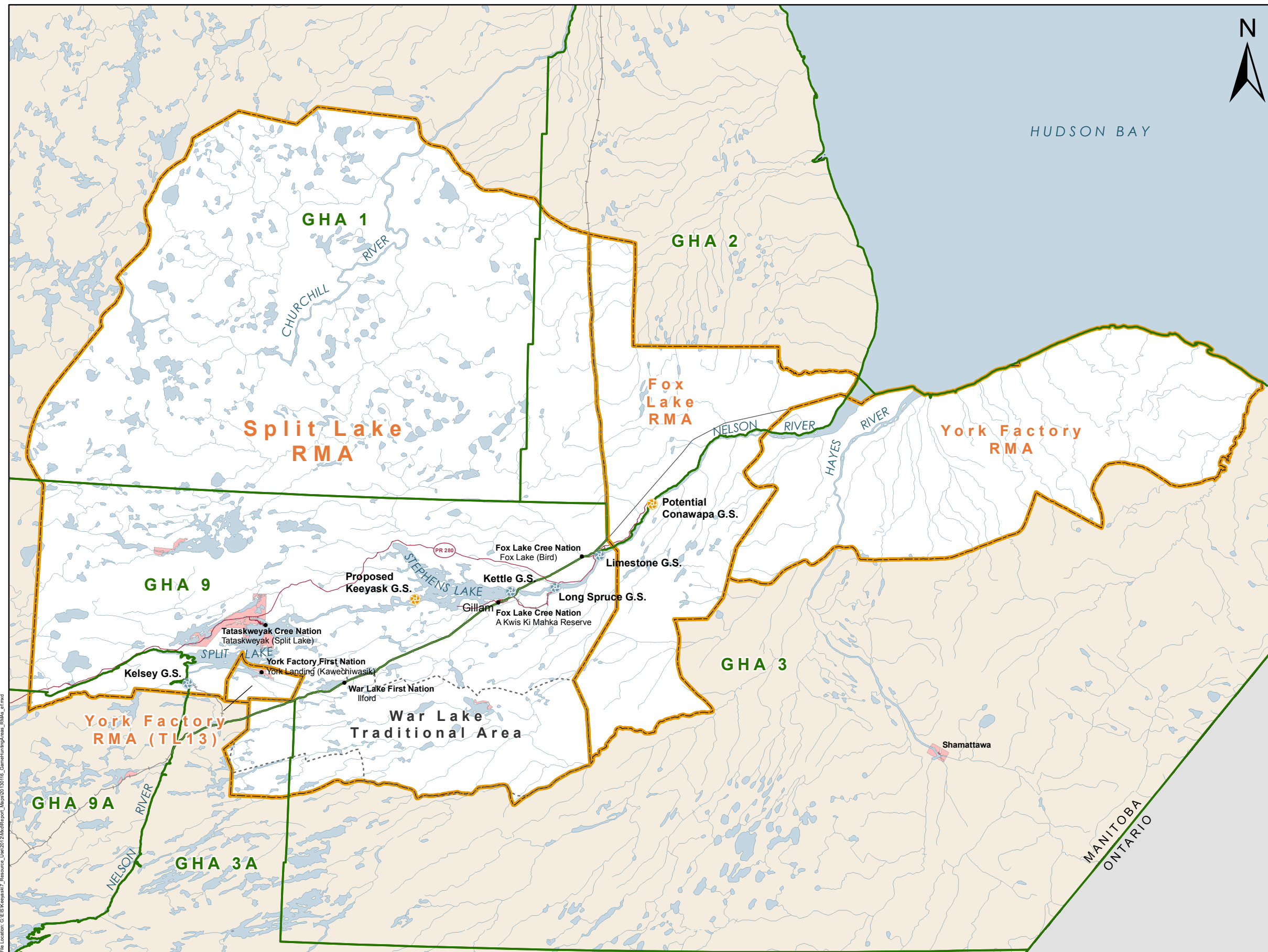

Project Footprint Overview

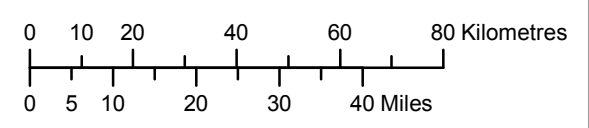
Construction and Operation Phase
