

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

### **OAK LAKE FOUR SEASONS ISLAND RESORT LTD. – WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM –FILE: 5588.00**

A proposal was filed by Oak Lake Four Seasons Island Resort Ltd. for the construction, expansion and operation of an existing wastewater collection system and a wastewater holding tank system that will service the seasonal resort and campground located in NW 29-8-24 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Sifton. Wastewater collected and stored in the wastewater management system will be pumped out of the holding tank system and trucked by licensed haulers to a wastewater treatment facility licenced pursuant to *The Environment Act*.
