

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

STRUCTURAL COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGIES LTD. – FIBERGLASS REINFORCED PLASTIC PRODUCTS MANUFACTURING FACILITY - FILE: 5594.00

A proposal has been filed on behalf of Structural Composite Technologies Ltd. for the continued operation of a fiberglass reinforced plastic products manufacturing facility at 100 Hoka Street in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The facility manufactures custom fabricated fiberglass reinforced plastic equipment for mining, milling, smelting, refining, processing and manufacturing companies. The potential environmental effects of the development are related to air emissions.
