Re: City of Thompson — Environment Act Licence No. 3118 R — Old Wastewater Treatment Plant — Decommissioning Plan Approval

Thank you for the April 1, 2022, plan to decommission the City of Thompson's old wastewater treatment plant, outfall pipe, and related components. Stantec Consulting Ltd. submitted the plan on your behalf. The plan fulfills the requirements of clauses 48 and 49 of Environment Act Licence No. 3118 R.

I approve the decommissioning plan as proposed, with the following conditions:

- 1. Transfer any liquid wastewater in the old wastewater treatment plant to the new wastewater treatment plant through the truck dump receiving station.
- 2. Transfer sludge solids from the old wastewater treatment plant to the lagoon only if the lagoon has enough capacity. Otherwise, transfer the sludge solids to another licensed wastewater treatment facility or waste disposal ground.
- 3. Transport wastewater and sludge solids in leak-proof containers.
- 4. Adhere to all provincial and federal requirements for handling, transporting, and disposing of hazardous materials.
