Re: Southwest Rapid Transit Corridor - Stage 2 Project - Environment Act Licence No. 3121 E

This is in regard to your letter dated March 19, 2019 requesting an alteration to the drainage plan submitted on June 18, 2015 by the City of Winnipeg in accordance with Clause 13 of Environment Act Licence No. 3121 E.

Manitoba Sustainable Development has confirmed that the property north of the project within the Parker Lands has been filled and is now at an elevation above the rapid transit corridor, therefore a berm to ensure project related drainage will not impact the property is no longer required.

The Environmental Approvals Branch is processing this request as a minor alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 3121 E, pursuant to clause 14(2)(b) of The Environment Act. It has been determined that the potential environmental effects from the alteration, as proposed, are insignificant and can be accommodated by the existing limits, terms and conditions of Environment Act Licence No. 3121E. In accordance with Section 14(2) of The Environment Act, I hereby grant approval to the City of Winnipeg to implement the alteration, as proposed in the March 19, 2019 letter.
