Air Quality Section has reviewed the above proposal and provides the following comments:

- It is expected that there will be no significant impact on air quality (a) if the cement silo is equipped with dust control equipment and is properly maintained, and (b) provided that other dust control measures (e.g., watering, pavement of high vehicle traffic area, sweeping etc.) as outlined in the Best Environmental Management Practices for Redi-Mix Concrete Plants (Manitoba Heavy Construction Association) are implemented.
- Air Quality Section suggests that the EA License clause regarding noise nuisance be included.
