

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* from the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

R.M. OF DAUPHIN RURAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM - FILE: 5746.00

A proposal has been filed by the Rural Municipality of Dauphin for the construction of a rural water supply system in the R.M. of Dauphin. This project consists of 276 km of 50 mm to 150 mm diameter water pipelines and five pressure reducing stations to serve approximately 2200 people throughout the Municipality. The project would connect to the G3 Water Cooperative rural water pipelines in the R.M. of Gilbert Plains and receive treated water from the G3 Co-op Water Treatment Plant. Construction is anticipated to occur in 2015 or 2016.
