This EAP notes water from the rural water distribution system will be used for staff purposes i.e. washrooms etc. but n ot in the process line. It also notes a fire sprinkler system will use water from a dugout. As such, all applicable provisions of *The Manitoba Plumbing Code* should be followed to ensure there is no cross connection between the public potable water system and the non-potable sprinkler water system.

Apart from this point, Office of Drinking Water has no further concerns with this EAP.
