

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

### **FEDERATED CO-OPERATIVES LIMITED – BRANDON BULK FERTILIZER STORAGE FACILITY - FILE: 5805.00**

A proposal has been filed by Federated Co-operatives Limited for the construction, operation and maintenance of a new bulk granular fertilizer storage and distribution facility to be located at 6701 and 8055 Richmond Avenue East in the City of Brandon. The development will consist of a 27, 500 tonne storage facility with concrete (4.9 m in height), with a fabric top. The facility will include an inload conveyor with a capacity to transfer 800 tonnes per hour of granular fertilizer. The site will also include a blender and a rail track that may accommodate up to 50 rail cars.
