DANGEROUS GOODS HANDLING AND TRANSPORTATION ACT APPLICATION

Currently the Rural Municipality of Mountain does not offer Used Oil, Antifreeze and Battery collection to any of our 1,103 residents. With such a large municipality the RM feels that a collection facility will provide a service that allows residents to recycle their waste oil, antifreeze and batteries in a convenient manner and help lessen the impact we have on the environment.

Description of Proposed Development

Used oil, used oil filters, used antifreeze, used oil and antifreeze containers and batteries will be accepted at the Birch River Waste Disposal Facility located on SE 31-39-25W. Please see attached Certificate of Title No. 165700 registered to the Rural Municipality of Mountain. This property and the adjacent property is zoned Agriculture General as per map attached.

The RM of Mountain wishes to collect all these recyclables through the Manitoba Association for Resource Recovery Corporation (MARRC). Under this program capital costs are on a 50% cost share up to \$8,000.00. Development of this depot will commence once licence is approved.

All used oils and antifreeze will be collected systematically by Notra Dame Used Oil Recycling out of Notra Dame, Manitoba. Used oil will be collected in a 1,955 L double walled ULC approved tank purchased through The Tank Shop. Notra Dame will supply 200L drums to collect used antifreeze and oil filters as well as large bags and stands to collect plastic containers. All collection containers will be kept under a shelter to prevent rainwater from collecting.

The waste disposal facility is supervised at all times during the hours of 9:00 am – 5:00 pm Wednesdays and Saturdays. Used oil and antifreeze will be left with trained waste disposal attendant to empty into the tanks. MARRC provide training to waste disposal attendants for handling of hazardous wastes.

Description of Existing Environment in the Project Area

Currently the SE 31-39-25W is used for our Waste Disposal facility and Lagoon site. Adding collection facility will be convenient for residents who wish to dispose of hazardous waste products.

Description of Environmental and Human Health Effects of the Proposed Development

Double walled tank, antifreeze drums and large bags will ensure that no pollutants are released and pose hazards to persons or the environment. The used oil tank will be placed on cement pad to ensure no seepage.

Mitigation Measures

Any spills will be quickly covered with absorbent, collected and stored in plastic containers for Notra Dame Pickup.

Fire extinguishers are kept on site in case of a fire at the collection depot. The Birch River Fire Department will be contacted immediately if such a fire occurs.

Collection and shipping of these products will be handled by Notra Dame Used Oil Recycling.

Follow-up Plans, including Monitoring and Reporting

Under the MARRC program, customers, licence plates and the number of liters or containers will be recorded and submitted.

Origin of Used Oil Products

For both the Cowan Waste Disposal Facility and Birch River Waste Disposal Facility the used oil will be received from both public and commercial operations. Approximately 85% public, 15% commercial.

Waste Batteries

Waste batteries will include automobile lead acid batteries at both locations.

Estimated Quantities and Max Capacity

These yearly estimates apply to both facilities:

Waste Batteries	Approx. 350 batteries/year	4 'x 4' x 3' Plastic Totes

Storage Details of Waste Batteries

Notra Dame Used Oil Recycling provide plastic totes (4' x 4' x 3') with lids to keep batteries out of rain or weather. They also will pick up used batteries once totes are at max capacity.

Good Afternoon Raj,

The RM of Mountain will be constructing shelters for both the Birch River and Cowan Used Oil Facilities where all collection containers will be stored, this would include the used battery totes. Batteries will be placed in totes (totes will be positioned on pallets) with layers of cardboard in between each layer to prevent short circuits. Notra Dame will pick up these totes once the batteries have been stacked 3 layers high. In the case of spillage, battery acid neutralizer will be stored on site.
