Good Morning,

It appears there is no mention of the burn cells contained within your licence. I just checked the proposal documents, and drawings, and it was included, but apparently was not included within the licence, it is not standard for class 1 licences to have burn areas, but is not without precedent.

An alteration to the licence will be required to allow the burning within the burn cells to occur, I will put that forward this week for Director consideration.

Regarding the burning at the compost pad, that would not be authorized due to the required separation distances and containment requirements from the Waste Management Facilities Regulation (50 metres from compost or other flammable materials and a berm enclosed area on three sides, respectively).

Hi Cory.

We are planning out the transition from our temporary compost site (in Town) to the new site at the landfill and had a question about the branches. In the past, branches could be dropped off at the former compost site by residents (free of charge) and periodically the Town would burn the branches. Since moving to the temporary site, we've been hauling branches to the landfill for burning there within the burn cell.

Under the new licence, is burning still permitted? I could not find a reference either way but perhaps I missed it. If burning is permitted, are we allowed to burn branches periodically at the new compost site? If not, would we need to transport all branches to the main burn area within the landfill site? Please let me know. Thanks.

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
