Dear Mr. Switzer,

We are writing to you regarding the "Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act" application from the above which was recently advertised.

We are homeowners in Deer Pointe Park, RM of Headingley, which is located south of Roblin Blvd near Hall Road and we are very concerned about the proposed location of the bulk storage facility and recycling depot. To help spread our concerns to the public, I was interviewed by Jeff Keele of CTV news today and his interview will be aired today during their 6pm news. We heard about this proposed site just last Friday and we are asking the government to extend the deadline for lodging complaints of July 4th a few days so that the voices of the residents may be heard.

We adamantly oppose the approval of the application for the following reasons:

- 1. We are concerned about the risk of spills of hazardous materials which could be devastating and/or deadly. Although Prairieview Terminals Ltd has created "spill mitigation measures" as described in their "Development Environment Assessment Report", accidents do happen. There is always a risk of human and/or mechanical error which can result in dangerous spills of hazardous materials. They even state there is a risk in section 4.4 of their "Development Environment Assessment Report". In addition to the harm a spill or mishandling can do, we are concerned that the RM of Headingley is not equipped to handle a catastrophic environmental spill.
- 2. Of great concern is the open-ended description (ie. "not limited to") of the types of hazardous materials that Prairieview Terminals Ltd will accept, store, process or handle on-site. Their "Development Environment Assessment Report", section 2.4 reads, "The waste transfer site will be designed to accept hazardous materials including, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, waste oils, glycol, used oil filters, oily water and sludge". From the same report, section 4.4 reads, "Hazardous materials that will be stored, processed or handled on-site include, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, used oil, blended oil, batteries and solvents". Without identifying the specific hazardous materials that the facility will accept, store, process and handle, it leaves the door open for Prairieview Terminals to handle other hazardous materials not identified specifically. That is a scary thought.
- 3. We are concerned about the negative impact to the positive reputation of Headingley. We moved here two years from Winnipeg because of the clean, safe, peaceful environment that Headingley provides. We are concerned that this new waste site will disrupt all of that and frankly, there can be a negative impact to our property values.
