Re: Notice of Alteration – Environment Act Licence 511 - New Lift Station and Forcemain

Thank you for your December 23, 2013 Notice of Alteration (NoA) to Environment Act Licence No. 511 for the Wellwood Colony wastewater treatment lagoon. The alteration consists of the construction of a new collection system including a lift station and forcemain to service the colony. No other changes to the operation of the wastewater treatment lagoon were proposed.

Upon review of your alteration request, I have concluded that the environmental effects of the proposed alteration will be insignificant, and, therefore, in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the December 23, 2013 Notice of Alteration.
